AUDIT REPORT - Chief Jack Dockery

Chief Dockery met with the auditor last week. He had no findings and just a few suggestions that we have implemented for a safe guard for ourselves. No findings on anything.

ELECTION RESULTS – Chief Jack Dockery

There is a resolution in front of you that needs to be read into the minutes, then signed by the Secretary, Mr. Eugene Swann.

This is the Notice of Special Elections, (Resolution no. 2026-014).

Mrs. Blackwell reads the Resolution accepting canvassing and votes cast for the Renewal of Tax of 10 mills for the period of 10 years. This tax purpose is for acquiring,, constructing, improving, maintaining and operating the District's fire protection facilities including equipment and paying cost of water for fire protection. A portion of this tax proceeds is required to contribute to the State and the State Wide retirement system.

The direction of distribution of the resolution was reviewed and this resolution was adopted with a roll call vote and the votes are as follows, 3 yeas, 0 nays and 1 absent. The Resolution number is 2026-014, accepted by the Board of Commissioner's of Fire District 11. This tax begins in 2027 and ends in 2037. The estimated cost for this election, determined by the Secretary of State, based on the provisions and actual cost of similar elections is \$2,200.

The Notice of Special Elections – read into the record by Mrs. Blackwell.

Mrs. Blackwell also reads the Resolution of Notice of Special Election held for the Renewal of Taxes for St. Tammany Fire Protection District No. 11. A roll call vote was called and voted on with 3 yeas, 0 nays and 1 absent. Motion carried. Both Resolutions are filed together as Resolution number 2026-014.
